Technical Discussion

Website Changes

An announcement was made that there is now a "Member Contact Info" on the AMI-SEC SharePoint site. This section is for members who wish to publish their contact information to establish conversations outside of the Listserv on security projects. The section is only viewable to members who are logged into the website. Members may wish to publish as much or as little information as they desire.

Also, the SharePoint problems are fixed in regard to permissions uploading documents.

ANSI C12.22

The chair discussed the new final draft of the ANSI C12.22 and the need to form rich communications between AMI-SEC and ANSI. The draft ANSI C12.22 can be found here: http://www.nema.org/stds/forums/ under ANSI C12.17 and then selecting ANSI C12.22.

The chair mentioned that AMI-SEC should review this standard and that although no deliverable was established at the beginning of the year, it would be short-sighted to not consider this standard. Several utilities mentioned that they are reviewing the standard now and that some states, such as Texas, are requiring the adoption of the standard. The draft is due for community submission October 6th where it will be open for a 30 day review/acceptance period.

Roadmap Document

The Roadmap document received formal comments and edits from AEP. The chair expressed the desire to ratify the document at the face-to-face October 24th. Editing clean-up will continue on the document.

Patent Awareness

The chair had mentioned that utilities should make themselves aware of current AMI patents. Southern California Edison held a webinar to explain their objectives and goals for the Use Case patents. Since then others have been discovered and due diligence surrounding intellectual property should be taken into account in an AMI deployment.

ASAP Status

The chair reminded the team that the Architectural Description document was distributed on the last call. No responses have been received. The System Security Requirements document is in the final stages. A rough draft has been published to the AMI-SEC SharePoint.
