## ASAP - D.C. Meetings

### ANSI C12.22 Update

Aaron Snyder presented an update of the ANSI C12.22 standard. Aaron presented and released a slide to the group discussing the process and changes of the C12.22 standard through the voting process. Permission was given by Ed Beroset to release the current version of ANSI C12.22 to the AMI-SEC Task Force for review.

### AMI System Security Requirements (SSR) - Draft for Review

Bobby Brown presented the changes since merging the Architectural Description (AD) document into the SSR. Comments presented by AEP and PG&E were addressed in the merging of the documents. Additional comments by Neil Greenfield on the SSR were incorporated into the version 0.92 draft for release. Bobby, Brad Singletary and James Ivers also completed a review and update of the functional requirements. The review included removing duplicate requirements, merging similar requirements and normalizing the requirement language.

Concern was raised that there may be representation of use cases missing. Doug Houseman proposed to work with Frances Cleveland to review Doug's (AMI) Benefits Definition document for missing material that should be included in the SSR (see action items).
